BIO: Sergeant Sgt. Zina Martinez is the Interim Director of the Northeast Ohio Regional Fusion Center (NEORFC) in Ohio Homeland Security Region II which covers a five county area and is located in Cleveland, Ohio. She is responsible for the day to day operations, strategic planning, budgeting, grant management, outreach, and intelligence and information sharing functions of the Fusion Center. She is a member of the FBI Joint Terrorism Task Force Executive Committee and coordinates the Fusion Center Governance Board.

Sgt. Zina Martinez has been a Cleveland Police Officer for over 21 years and previously worked as a Cleveland Police Dispatcher and Cuyahoga County Corrections Officer. During her tenure with the Division of Police she has served in Patrol Operations, The Strike Force Unit (investigating crime trends and developing intelligence sources), Patrol Supervisor, Administrative Operations, and is the Administrative Sergeant for the Bureau of Homeland Services. In this role she participates in Emergency Operation Center activations and in the planning and executing of large scale events such as; the Republican National Convention, National Senior Games, Rite-Aid Cleveland Marathon, Tall Ships Challenge, Cleveland Rocks New Year's Eve 2013, 2014 and others. Her Intelligence Liaison Officer (ILO) and Incident Command System (ICS) training, experience, and agency partnerships contributed to the safe success of these events.

Sgt. Martinez is a proud United States Army Veteran, native New Yorker (NYC), fluent in Spanish, and has earned a Bachelor of Arts in Organizational Leadership Management from Baldwin-Wallace University along with several related certificates. Her commitment to service is evidenced by participation various committees and founding membership "2nd District Annual Baby Shower", for the Providence House, a crisis nursery committed to child abuse prevention and family preservation.

In her spare time she enjoys family time, traveling, from Iceland to the Caribbean, advocating for animals, and catching up on a good book.
